### EDUCATION DEPARTMENT OPPORTUNITY

The Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art at the University of Oregon offers Laurel Award Internships which provide hands-on museum experience in education and art education. Graduate students interested in museum careers or in learning more about the functions of an art museum are invited to apply. A Laurel Award Internships, available for one to three terms, is equivalent to a 500-level graduate course, and carries five credits per term. Interns must commit to 12-15 hours per week to the Museum for which they **receive full tuition reimbursement for each term selected.**

Applicant for Laurel Award Internships must:

- be a full-time enrolled graduate student for the academic year 2007-2008
- have a GPA of 3.0 or higher

- cover letter outlining how the internship experience will enhance scholarly or professional goals
- resume/curriculum vita
- writing sample(s)
- two letters of recommendation
